

I was a little disappointed in Margo's second book. True, it is nicely produced, with good illustrations and instructions. Margo has a real talent for combining different textures and colours to make her projects. The book is a felting equivalent to a book of knitting patterns, and if you don't want to make the projects, then the book has only a few tips to help you make your own designs. If you look on the front and back cover, that is mainly what you will find in the book. An easy way to have improved the book would have been to include different variations of colour of the same projects, or the same felting ideas used on different sizes or different objects. Personally I am not about to make needle-felted tea cosies, or lampshades, as shown here.

Making More *Needle-Felting Magic* offers new techniques and projects for needle-felting, offering techniques combining machine needle felting, free-motion quilting, and wet-felting and providing

projects and step-by-step directions conducive to beginner efforts. Eight projects range from a wrap to a tea cozy and are perfect for either beginners or those moving to the next level.

There are some really creative projects in this book -- I only wish I had a machine to felt with instead of just one needle!

The book starts off with 10 pages of instructions which provide you with the basics to get started. It is followed by eight projects which include a lamp shade, a tea cozy, a pillow and a bag. Each project has a color photo and the size of the finished project. A materials list is provided and templates are included if needed. The instructions walk you through the "how-to" of the project. The items have a worn, antique look to them. This is a good book for anyone wanting to make a felted project and there is a variety of items to create.
