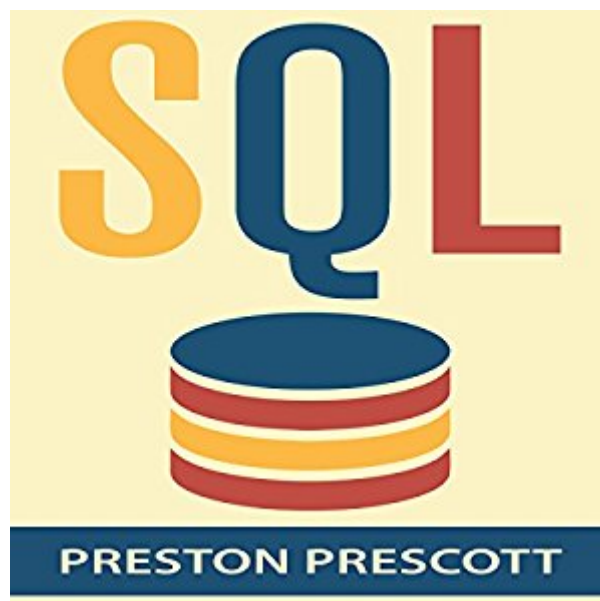

I'm don't understand why this has as many positive reviews as it does. My primary issues summarized as follows (in order of importance): - It is very short. There are 90 pages total. Those pages are smaller than average, the font size is large with 1.5 line spacing, and there is a lot of white-space. I have no experience with SQL, and read this carefully in less than an hour. - For the reason above, this item (I won't call it a book) is very overpriced. - It is not professionally edited or published, which would not be a problem except that many errors were not caught.

First and foremost: \$18 for this book is grossly overpriced. It's about 100 pages, and offers a very basic introduction to SQL. For absolute beginners, it is a handy resource with good step-by-step instructions and small waypoint projects to ensure one understands commands/syntax/etc. It was the first SQL book I purchased while learning and I've found it very approachable: it is well laid-out and systematic in its approach. I would recommend purchasing it for Kindle (or any other e-book format) and reading it on your computer while simultaneously working in your preferred SQL. It's short and informational enough to provide a solid introduction to basic database use, manipulation, and analysis.

I got this book to help me at work, since a lot of what I do involves working with SQL databases. The author, Preston Prescott, does a very good job of laying out the basics of SQL, and then explaining the various intricacies one should become familiar with in order to create functioning databases. Even though it is a difficult language to learn and apply, this book helps simplify it a lot. I received this book for free in exchange for my honest and unbiased review.

This book is an excellent resource for learning how to store categorized documents on my computer without using unnecessary space on my hard drive. It has a very informative simple step by step guide and other valuable information that is very useful for anyone that uses a computer! You cannot ever go wrong when purchasing this book.
