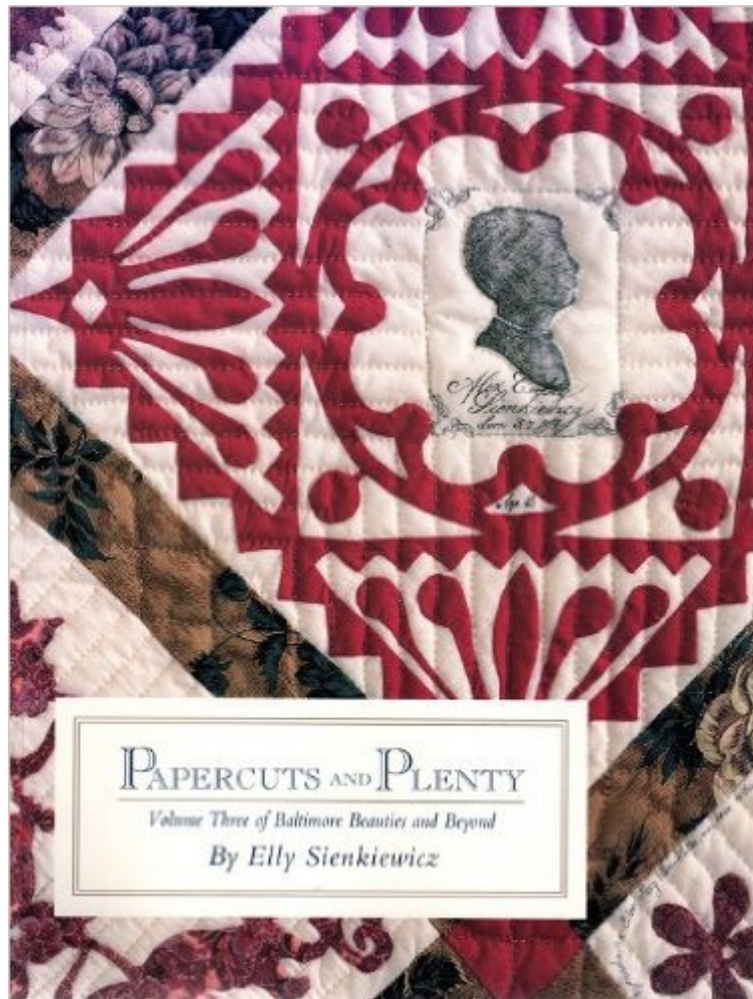

I like to iron the freezer paper onto the applique fabric and trace around it. Then I layer the applique and background fabrics and baste together. The book came very quickly and in excellent condition.
