

As a first-generation Cape Verdean living far away from our USA home of southern New England, I am definitely content with this book. The recipes can sometimes be a little odd to follow because of their obscurity, but I would like to believe the vagueness on measurements and ingredients is the same flexibility Cape Verdeans use in their dishes anyway. I've already made a few dishes from this book and they turned out okay despite first attempts. It'll take a little getting used to for perfection, but practice makes perfect.

My husband is Cape Verdean. I always wanted to impress him with dishes from his country, so this is a start. Another reviewer indicated the book is a copy; that's correct. The author might want to

reprint the book. The recipes are written in both languages which is great. I'm learning some of the words so that I can impress my mother-in-law. All in all great book for anyone needing a Cape Verdean recipe.

It gets five stars from me. There is a wealth of appetizing recipes, both main courses and desserts. Drinks are not missing either. The recipes are realistic to make and flexible. There is always margin for some small changes, you can opt for omitting an ingredient and can adjust to what is available where you are. It is also interesting culturally. Some recipes resemble others from the Lusophone world, like cachupa, very much like feijoada in Portugal and Brazil.
